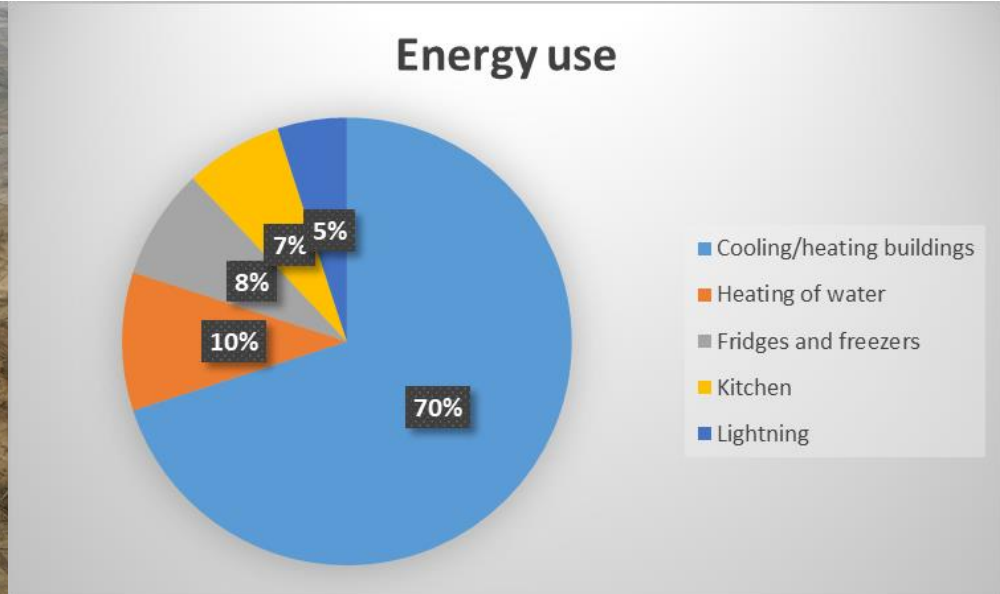




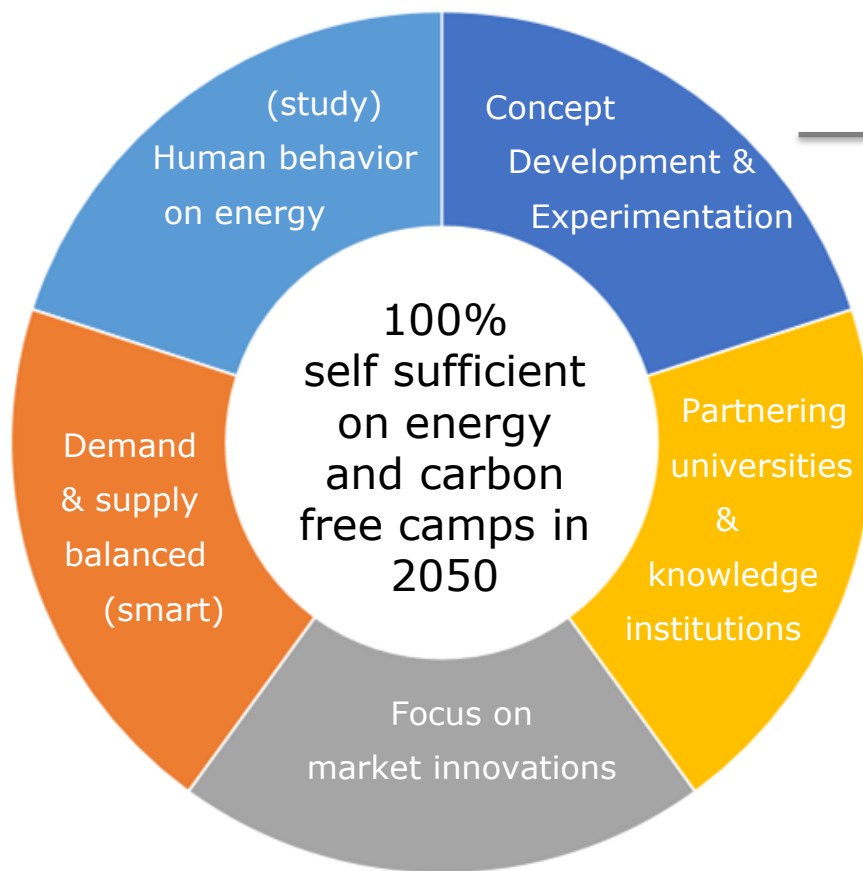
# Current situation
